

A major challenge in 2025: declining donations

One concerning issue remains this year: the insufficient level of donations from churches and individuals. At this point in the fiscal year (March 2025), we should have received approximately 75% of the expected contributions – that is, \$214,725 out of an annual goal of \$286,300. However, to date we have collected only \$150,490, which represents 53% of the target. Several factors explain this delay: the Canada Post strike has significantly disrupted mail delivery, some of our faithful donors are currently facing major health challenges, and others have gone to be with the Lord. This situation is worrisome, as tuition revenue will no longer increase between now and the end of our financial year, and the contributions from our church families will remain stable, as budgeted. This leaves us with only one lever to close the gap: the generosity of our individual and church donors. Your support is vital to ETEQ's mission, and we sincerely thank you for being part of this wonderful journey.
